

SECOND ORDER REGARDING ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION

On May 7, 2008, the Commission issued an Order reopening this proceeding “for the purpose of taking further evidence,” *Verucci Motorcycles, LLC v. Senator International Ocean, LLC*, FMC No. 06-05, slip op. at 5 (May 7, 2008) (Order Reopening the Proceeding), and remanding it to the presiding Administrative Law Judge. The Commission’s Order directed that I “instruct the parties upon the availability of alternative dispute resolution (ADR), and . . . determine whether the matter should be referred to the Office of Consumer Affairs and Dispute Resolution Services to assist the parties.” *Id.* at 5-6. Pursuant to this direction, I directed the parties to contact Ronald D. Murphy, the Commission’s Alternative Dispute Resolution Specialist, to discuss the feasibility of resolving this matter through alternative dispute resolution. I asked Mr. Murphy to advise me in writing: (1) whether each party has complied with the directive to consult with the Commission’s Alternative Dispute Resolution Specialist; and (2) whether the parties agree to engage in alternative dispute resolution. *Verucci Motorcycles, LLC v. Senator International Ocean, LLC*, FMC No. 06-05 (ALJ May 8, 2008) (Order Regarding Alternative Dispute Resolution).

I have been advised by Mr. Murphy that “both parties to the subject proceeding have contacted me and agreed to mediate the matter. I will be contacting them next week with respect to arranging for the mediation.” See attached email dated Friday May 16, 2008, 2:31 PM from Ronald Murphy to Clay Guthridge. Therefore, I ask Mr. Murphy to advise me in writing on June 13, 2008, or on such earlier date as he deems appropriate, whether the parties have reached a settlement.
