**THE PORT AUTHORITY'S CONSENT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF A CASE
MANAGEMENT ORDER**

Respondent, the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey (the "Port Authority"), with the consent and agreement of Complainant, Maher Terminals LLC ("Maher") (collectively the "Parties"), submits this Consent Motion for Entry of a Case Management Order, which supersedes the Port Authority's previously filed Motion for a Case Management Order and Maher's objections to that motion. The Parties agree that additional discovery is not required. The Parties have met and conferred and respectfully request that the Federal Maritime Commission ("the Commission") enter a Case Management Order providing the following briefing schedule with respect to the Parties' submissions

Maher reserves its right to seek leave to file a sur-reply, although the Port Authority reserves its right to oppose that request. The foregoing agreement concerning the briefing schedule expressly took account of counsel's professional commitments.

Accordingly, the Port Authority hereby requests that the Commission enter a Case Management Order with the proposed briefing schedule listed above with Maher's consent.

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
