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**Order Granting in Part Joint Motion to Extend Stay Through  
September 30, 2016**

On August 10, 2016, the Commission stayed all proceedings in this action through September 2, 2016, pending the outcome of settlement negotiations. On September 9, 2016, the Commission extended the stay through September 16, 2016. And on September 21, 2016, the Commission extend the stay through September 23, 2016.


The parties have now moved to extend the stay through September 30, 2016, so that they can negotiate the details of a

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settlement agreement. Although the Commission has a significant interest in promoting settlement and conserving resources, the latter concern is undermined by the parties' serial motions. Further, the Commission has a significant interest in resolving cases in a timely fashion.

We therefore **GRANT** the parties' motion in part and **ORDER** all proceedings in this action stayed through and including October 31, 2016. If the parties have not entered into a settlement agreement and filed it with the Commission by that date, consistent with the Commission's June 21, 2016, Order to File Supplemental Briefs, Maher shall file its response brief by November 14, 2016, and the Port Authority shall file its reply brief December 12, 2016.
