

VERIFIED COMPLAINT

Complainants, AFI Elektromekanik Ve Elektronik San. Tic. Ltd. Sti. ("AFI")¹ and DNB Exports LLC ("DNB"), by their attorneys, Rodriguez O'Donnell Gonzalez & Williams, P.C., hereby file their Verified Complaint against Respondents Barsan Barsan Global Lojistiks Ve Gumruk Musavirligi A. S. ("BGL")², Barsan International, Inc. ("Barsan Int'l"), and Impexia Inc. ("Impexia") pursuant to Section 10(b)(13) of the Shipping Act of 1984, as amended by the Ocean Shipping Reform Act of 1998 (the "Shipping Act"), 46 U.S.C. §41103 (a), and pursuant to the Federal Maritime Commission's ("FMC") authority under Section 11 (a) of the Shipping Act, 46 U.S.C. § 41301 (a), and allege upon information and belief the following:

PARTIES

1. AFI is a corporation organized and existing pursuant to the laws of Turkey, with its principal place of business at Serifali Mahallesi, Emin Sok. No: 51 P.K. 34775, ÜMRANIYE / İSTANBUL, Turkey. AFI has been a wholesale distributor of U.S. standard electrical goods to construction firms in the Greater Middle East for the past fifteen years.

2. DNB is a corporation organized and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of Delaware, with its principal place of business at 110 Harmon Dr, Unit 106 Blackwood, NJ 08012. DNB acts as AFI's procurement agent in the United States.

3. Upon information and belief, Respondent BGL is a corporation organized and existing pursuant to the laws of Turkey with its principal place of business at Merkez Mahallesi Nadide Sok. No.1, Barsan Business Center, 34381 Şişli, İstanbul, Turkey.

4. Upon information and belief, Respondent Barsan Int'l is BGL's subsidiary and is a corporation organized and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of New York with its principal place of business at 17-09 Zink Place Unit 5, Fair Lawn, NJ, 07410. Barsan Int'l is licensed as a non-vessel operating common carrier ("NVOCC") in the waterborne foreign commerce of the United States and as a freight forwarder (FMC License No. 004656NF, Org No. 015750), pursuant to the Shipping Act and 46 C.F.R. § 515.21 et al. and 46 C.F.R. Part 520 of the Federal Maritime Commission Regulations. Barsan's surety bonds (Bond Nos 571625 and 571626) were issued by Washington International Insurance Company).

5. Upon information and belief, Respondent Barsan Int'l also registered in the States of New Jersey and Florida respectively as a foreign corporation. Barsan Int'l has not registered the Florida or New York locations with the FMC as branch offices.

6. Upon information and belief, Respondent Impexia is a corporation incorporated on or about March, 2010, and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of New Jersey with its principal place of business initially located at 17-09 Zink Place Unit 5, Fair Lawn, NJ, 07410, the same location as Barsan Int'l.

7. Upon information and belief, BGL also incorporated Barsan Global Logistics Corp in the State of New Jersey with its principal place of business at 17-09 Zink Place Unit 5, Fair Lawn, NJ, 07410, the same location as Barsan Int'l.

8. Upon information and belief, Mr. Ugur Aksu serves as President for Barsan Int'l. and Barsan Global Logistics Corp.

9. Upon information and belief, Barsan Int'l is so organized and controlled, and its affairs are so conducted as to make it a mere sham, agent, or adjunct of BGL, that its separate existence as a distinct corporate entity should be ignored, and the two corporations should be regarded legally as a single corporate unit. BGL presents Barsan Int'l to the shipping public as BGL's U.S. office, and Barsan Int'l presents itself to the shipping public as a division of BGL, and Barsan Int'l's bills of lading, invoices and other documents carry the BGL logo. See Exhibit 1., BGL Profile Provided by Wikipedia, Barsan Int'l Identified as BGL US Office (s) at BGL Wet-site, Barsan Int'l Invoice and Bills of Lading, and Contract Carrier Agreement.

10. Upon information and belief, Impexia is a mere corporate shell of BGL and Barsan Int'l for the purpose of obtaining and utilizing BGL's and/or Barsan Int'l's

customers commercial proprietary information, which is routinely obtained for performing Barsan Int'l's NVOCC/freight forwarding/NVOCC services, with the purpose of engaging in the same business as Barsan Intl's customers and to solicit import/export trading business from their customers' clients.

FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

11. During the period commencing on or about January 2009 continuing through on or about the middle of January, 2011, Barsan Int'l provided NVOCC services to DNB and AFI for shipments originating at U.S. Ports for delivery at Ports in Turkey and other ports and points pursuant to a "Contract Carrier Agreement" ("Agreement") executed on January 15, 2009. The Agreement states: "Barsan International, Inc., International Freight Forwarder-NVOCC. A Division of Barsan Global Logistics."³ See Exhibit 2., Contract Carrier Agreement.

12. Pursuant to the Agreement, DNB provided Barsan Int'l export documentation, shipment information, shipper and consignee information, including commercial invoices, and other information required for transportation and exports.

13. In addition to the requirement by the Shipping Act of 1984, as amended prohibiting Barsan Int'l from misusing proprietary business sensitive information, the Agreement contains a CONFIDENTIALITY provision stating:

Each party agrees to consider as strictly confidential all proprietary business information received from the other party, especially customer information, rates, carrier contracts and associated plans, methods of operation or techniques of doing business.

14. Upon information and belief, Impexia was incorporated on March 11, 2010 in the State of New Jersey and acts as a trading company exporting electrical goods to Turkey and other ports and points using information obtained through invoices and other documentation provided to Barsan Int'l, and unlawfully soliciting DNB's and/or AFI's customers directly.

15. Upon information and belief, Impexia is a mere corporate shell of BGL and Barsan Int'l for the purpose of obtaining and utilizing BGL's and/or Barsan Int'l's customers commercial proprietary information, which is routinely obtained for performing Barsan Int'l's NVOCC/freight forwarding/NVOCC services, with the purpose of engaging in the same business as DNB and/or AFI and to solicit import/export trading business from DNB's and/or AFI's customers.

16. The intentions of BGL and/or Barsan Int'l are further demonstrated, among other things, by obtaining business from its customers, including DNB/AFI, by structuring its NVOCC business on a break even, non-profit basis.

17. Upon information and belief, Mr. Jimmy Cuneyt Karadagli holds out as the owner of Impexia. Mr. Jimmy Cuneyt Karadagli, at all relevant times to this Complaint, is the husband of Ms. Burcin Karadagli, Accounting Manager of Barsan Int'l located at the New Jersey location.

18. Upon information and belief, Impexia and Barsan Int'l initially, upon the formation of Impexia, shared the same business address in New Jersey. See Exhibit 3., Impexia's Prior Web-sites and Impexia Invoice.

19. Upon information and belief, Impexia stopped indicating that its offices were located at the same location as Barsan Int'l when Respondents became aware that

Complainant had obtained knowledge of Impexia and its unlawful scheme, on or about, December, 2010. At this time Respondents changed its address on its web-site. See Exhibit 4., Impexia's Current Web-site.

20. Impexia indicates on its web-site that it has three offices in New Jersey, Florida and Texas, which upon information and belief are close to Barsan Int'l's or BGL's offices in these three States. Further, Impexia only has one contact telephone no., i.e. a New Jersey no., for the three offices. Exhibit 4., Impexia's Current Web-site.

21. Impexia used to display its business address in New Jersey as the same address as Barsan Int'l's address in its web-site. Mr. Jimmy Cuneyt Karadagli's full name was also displayed in the Impexis webpage. See Exhibit 3., Impexia's Prior Web-sites and Impexia Invoices.

22. Barsan Int'l's officers, President Ugur Aksu, Vice President, Sevgi Cebe and Export Manager Tugsan Uresin, also maintain a close relationship with Impexia. See Exhibit 5., Barsan Int'l's officers' Names and Pictures Listed as Mr. Cuneyt Karadagli's Friends at His Facebook page.

23. In addition to the business information provided by DNB to Barsan Int'l for transportation and exports purposes, Barsan Int'l's officers intentionally and fraudulently solicited and received sensitive business information by inviting Mr. Baris Devrim Bal, Managing Director of DNB, for informal lunch and dinner business meetings. These informal business meetings which started in 2009, turned more frequent at the beginning of 2010, and abruptly stopped after March 2010 when Impexia was incorporated. During some of these meetings Barsan Int'l's President, Mr. Aksu, and other employees complained to Mr. Bal about their working conditions at Barsan Int'l

and told Mr. Bal of their intentions and interest to set up their own business or form a partnership with Mr. Bal. During one of these dinner meetings at a New Jersey restaurant, around January 2010, Barsan Int'l officers presented a "hypothetical" scenario to Mr. Bal: "If we had \$100,000, what kind of business could we set up or how would you run a business with that kind of money?" Mr. Bal responded by saying that the economy is not prime for setting up a new business, and that everyone should focus on the profession they're good at.

24. AFI and DNB first became aware of Barsan Int'l's and Impexia's scheme around December 2010 when AFI and DNB bid a project with their customer Ceytun Construction Co., ("Ceytun"). Kandahar, Afghanistan, by quoting \$250,000, and Ceytun informed AFI and DNB that Impexia quoted \$200,000 for this project and also enclosed a copy of Impexia's invoice. Ceytun was a long time customer of AFI and DNB. See See Exhibit 3., Impexia's Prior Web-sites and Impexia Invoice. The Impexia invoice demonstrates that Impexia was sharing the same business address with Barsan Int'l, and also carries the alleged owner's, Mr. Karadagli, signature. AFI and DNB raised the issue of illegality of BGL, Barsan Int'l and Impexia's practice to Ceytun. As a result of Respondents' actions, DNB and AFI have lost this business.

25. Upon information and belief, Barsan Int'l knowingly disclosed and Impexia received information concerning the nature, kind, quantity, destination, shipper, consignee, and routing of the property tendered relating to Ceytun, Complainants' customer without the consent of DNB and/or AFI and used that information to the detriment and disadvantage to DNB and/or AFI, and inappropriately disclosed that information to Impeixa as a competitor of DNB and AFI.

26. Since DNB and AFI communicated to BGL, Barsan Int'l and Impeixa through Ceytun alleging that BGL and/or Barsan Int'l released their business information with regard to Ceytun, and that Impexia and Impexia solicited their customers, and requesting that they cease and desist from stealing their customers, Impeixa's website has started going through a series of updates about their contact information including but not limited to removal of its address which was the same as Barsan Int'l's and Mr. Karadgagli's name and e-mail address was also removed from the web-site. Further, Impexia subsequently and currently display Mr. and Mrs. Karadgali's residential address as Impexia's business address on Impexia's invoices. See Exhibit 6., Impexia's Invoice Issued to Metag Construction.

27. AFI and DNB again became aware of Barsan Int'l's and Impexia's continuing scheme in March, 2011 of misusing Complainants' customer information when AFI and DNB was provided a copy of Impexia's invoice to Metag Construction, Ankara, Turkey. Metag Construction was a long time customer of AFI and DNB. See Exhibit 6., Impexia's Invoice Issued to Metag Construction.

28. Upon information and belief, Barsan Int'l knowingly disclosed and Impexia received information concerning the nature, kind, quantity, destination, shipper, consignee, and routing of the property tendered relating to Metag Construction, Complainants' customer without the consent of DNB and/or AFI and used that information to the detriment and disadvantage to DNB and/or AFI, and inappropriately disclosed that information to Impeixa as a competitor of DNB and AFI.

29. Mr. Burak Bal, General Manager of AFI, on behalf of DNB and AFI again in March, 2011 communicated to Mr. Kamil Barlin, the owner of BGL, in Istanbul,

Turkey, alleging that Barsan Int'l released their business information to Impexia and Impexia solicited their customers. Mr. Barlin acknowledged Barsan Int'l's wrong doings and advised that BGL would compensate AFI and DNB for the loss caused by Barsan Int'l's releasing their business information.

30. Upon information and belief, after DNB and AFI raised their claims against BGL and Barsan Int'l, and after BGL and Barsan Int'l acknowledged those unlawful practices, Ms. Karadagli and other officers of Barsan Int'l involved in the scheme subject of this proceeding still maintain their key positions at the management team of Barsan Int'l, and Mr. Karadagli still holds out to be the owner of Impexia.

31. Upon information and belief, Impexia received AFI and/or DNB's business and customers information from BGL and Barsan Int'l and solicited business from AFI and/or DNB's important customers, including but not limited to Sasel Insaat Taah Tic. Ve San Ltd. Sti., Yuksel Insaat and 77 Construction Contracting & Trading Company, in addition to Ceytun and Metag.

32. Upon information and belief, BGL and Barsan Int'l knowingly routinely disclosed to Impexia, a competitor of DNB and/or AFI, and Impexia knowingly received information concerning the nature, kind, quantity, destination, shipper and consignee identities, and routing of the property tendered or delivered to Barsan Int'l by DNB and AFI, for hundreds of shipments with a value of millions of dollars, without the consent of DNB and/or AFI, and used that information to the detriment and disadvantage of DNB and/or AFI, such disclosures and scheme, thereby violating Section 10 (b) (13) of the Shipping Act, 46 U.S.C. § 41103 (a).

33. When BGL and/or Barsan Int'l provided NVOCC services to AIF and/or DNB, BGL's and/or Barsan Int'l's officers **repeatedly** stated that they were not making any profits from their NVOCC business by shipping BGL's and/or AFI's cargo. DNB and AFI are now aware of BGL, Barsan Int'l and Impexia's scheme, and DNB and AFI now understand their scheme i.e. a fraudulent business model by providing their NVOCC services at little to no profit for the purposes of exploiting, receiving and soliciting information obtained through NVOCC business, and by unlawfully competing with their customers by setting up another company, i.e. Impexia in this case, to make unlawful profits.

34. As a direct consequence of the unlawful conduct engaged in by Respondents, Complainants have suffered loss of clients, current and future revenues from those clients, not only loss amounts represented by shipments with Respondents, but also with other forwarders, and loss of reputation, all of which has caused and continues to cause Complainants monetary damages of at least \$ 1.2 million, and other significant amounts which will be proved during the course of this proceeding.

VIOLATIONS

35. Respondents' BGL, Barsan Int'l, acting on their own behalf and as a mere shell of BGL, and Impexia as BGL's and Barsan Int'l's alter ego by knowingly disclosing, offering, soliciting and receiving information concerning the nature, kind, quantity, destination, shipper, consignee, and routing of the property tendered or delivered to Barsan Int'l by DNB and/or AFI, by, without the consent of DNB and/or AFI, using that information to the detriment and disadvantage of DNB and/or AFI, by

unlawfully disclosing that information to Impeixa as a competitor have violated Section 10 (b) (13) of the Shipping Act, 46 U.S.C. § 41103 (a).

DAMAGES

36. As a direct consequence of the unlawful conduct engaged in by Respondents, Complainants have suffered injury as provided herein, and as may be further demonstrated in this proceeding, and seeks relief as provided below.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Complainants respectfully request that the Commission issue the following relief:

1. An Order compelling Respondents to Answer the charges made herein and scheduling a hearing in Washington, D.C. during which the Commission may receive evidence in this matter;

2. An Order holding that the Respondents BGL's, Barsan Int'l's and/or Impexia's activities described herein were unlawful and in violation of the Shipping Act;

3. An Order compelling Respondents BGL, Barsan Int'l and/or Impexia to jointly and severally make reparations to Complainants DNB and AFI in the amount as may be proven during the course of this proceeding, with interest as may be lawfully permitted by law, costs, and attorneys' fees;

4. An Order compelling Respondents BGL, Barsan Int'l and Impexia to cease and desist their activities in violation of the Shipping Act as alleged herein;

5. An Order revoking Respondent Barsan Int'l's NVOCC and freight forwarder license, and further prohibiting Respondents BGL, Barsan Int'l and its officers from doing NVOCC and freight forwarding business in the U.S.: and

6. Such other and further relief as the Commission deems just and proper.

ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION

The Commission's informal dispute resolution procedures have not been used prior to the filing of the Complaint. Counsel for the Complainants has not consulted with the Commission's Dispute Resolution Specialist about utilizing alternative dispute resolution (ADR) under the Commission's ADR Program.

A hearing is requested in Washington, D.C.

"Impexia" refers to Impexia Inc., and shall embrace and include, in addition to Impexia, all agents, employees, servants, representatives, attorneys, private investigators, accountants and any and all others who are in a position to obtain or who may have obtained information for or on behalf of Impexia.

G. 




