

ORDER REQUIRING JOINT STATUS REPORT

The parties have filed a number of motions in this proceeding. These motions may be impacted by subsequent decisions issued in a related case. In an effort to resolve the issues in this proceeding, the parties shall meet and confer to determine whether any pending motions or issues can be resolved. If any issues raised in pending motions have been resolved, they should be withdrawn. If additional briefing is required prior to rendering rulings on any of the pending motions, a request should be made for additional briefing. In addition, a schedule needs to be set for this proceeding. Accordingly, the parties shall file a joint status report with a proposed schedule.

In the joint status report, the parties shall: (1) identify pending motions and indicate whether those motions are ready for decision, (2) indicate whether the parties intend to file any additional motions, (3) describe the status of discovery, (4) specify agreements made between the parties to expedite this proceeding, in addition to the agreements to which the parties have previously stipulated, and (5) propose a schedule. The parties are reminded that the Commission has set October 8, 2014, as the deadline for an Initial Decision in this proceeding.

Upon consideration of the foregoing, it is hereby **ORDERED** that on or before June 4, 2014, the parties meet and confer and file a joint status report with proposed schedule as described above.
