
THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NEW YORK AND NEW JERSEY

ORDER REQUIRING JOINT STATUS REPORT

On December 18, 2015, the Commission served an order remanding this case for further proceedings on counts I, VI, VIII, and XII. The Commission dismissed the remaining counts and all other pending motions.

The parties will be required to meet and confer to discuss what additional discovery, beyond that obtained in this and the other related proceedings, is required. The parties shall also identify any motions that they intend to file and whether any stipulations or settlement are possible. The parties shall jointly propose a schedule that ensures a prompt resolution of the remaining counts.

For the above-stated reasons, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the parties meet and confer and file a joint status report addressing the status of discovery, motions, stipulations, settlement, and a proposed schedule by January 19, 2016.
