## **Order Scheduling New Date For Oral Argument**

By Order served December 18, 2013, the Commission granted Complainants' Request for Oral Argument. On December 24, 2013, the Commission granted the parties joint motions to extend the briefing deadlines and postpone oral argument. On January 23, 2014, the Commission issued an Order scheduling oral argument for March 27, 2014. Complainants on January 28, 2014, filed an unopposed motion and memorandum asking that oral

argument be held on or about April 3, 2014 because counsel for Complainants is scheduled for a conference and programs in Anchorage during the week of March 27, 2014.

Notice is given that the matter is scheduled for oral argument on April 3, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. Complainants will appear first. Complainants will be allotted a total of 30 minutes for argument, a portion of which may be reserved for rebuttal. Respondents will be allotted a total of 30 minutes for argument. By March 3, 2014, the parties shall file with the Secretary the name of the person who will argue on their behalf. This filing shall conform with the service requirements of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 46 C.F.R. Part 502, and shall be addressed and delivered to the Secretary, Federal Maritime Commission, 800 North Capitol Street, NW, Washington, D.C. 20573, or via email at [secretary@fmc.gov](mailto:secretary@fmc.gov).
