

**GLOBAL LINK LOGISTICS, INC.'S PETITION TO WITHDRAW EXCEPTIONS AND
DISMISS COMPLAINT WITH PREJUDICE**

Complainant Global Link Logistics, Inc. ("Global Link"), by and through its attorneys, hereby petitions the Federal Maritime Commission ("Commission") pursuant to Rule 73 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 46 C.F.R. § 502.73, to withdraw its Exceptions to Initial Decision and for dismissal of its Complaint with prejudice. As set forth in Global Link's and Hapag Lloyd AG's ("Hapag Lloyd") Joint Petition for Approval of Settlement, which is being filed concurrently with this Petition, the parties have resolved this matter through a mutually agreed settlement. This settlement fully and finally disposes of all disputes and issues between Global Link and Hapag Lloyd with respect to the matters subject of this Proceeding. As consideration for the settlement, Global Link has agreed to withdraw its exceptions to the Initial Decision Granting Respondent's Motion to Dismiss and to dismiss its Complaint with prejudice. Because the settlement is fair, correct and valid, and does not contravene any law or public policy, Global Link submits that this Petition to withdraw its exceptions to the Initial Decision

and dismiss its Complaint with prejudice should be granted. A form of Order to that effect is attached.
