January 8, 2015	Discovery closes

The parties are ordered to file joint status reports on October 10, 2014, December 10, 2014, and January 14, 2015. The December 10, 2014, status report should address the following matters: (1) The parties must propose a schedule for submission of proposed findings of fact, appendices with documentary evidence supporting the proposed findings, and briefs; (2) If a party or parties believe that an oral hearing is necessary, the parties should identify with particularity the issues that cannot be resolved without a hearing and/or the nature of the matters in issue that require a hearing. If the parties believe that an oral hearing is necessary, they must propose a location for the hearing. The presiding judge will determine the necessity of an oral hearing and place of the hearing.
