**ORDER FOR COMPLAINANTS TO FILE REVISED PROPOSED FINDING OF FACT**

---


The Order governing briefing for the Initial Decision sets forth the requirements for a party's proposed findings of fact.

This document must set forth proposed findings of fact in numbered paragraphs. Each paragraph must be limited as nearly as practicable to a single factual proposition. Each factual proposition must be followed by an exact citation to evidence that the party contends will support the proposed finding of fact; *i.e.*, a page number in the Appendix.

*Santa Fe Discount Cruise Parking, Inc., d/b/a EZ Cruise Parking, Lighthouse Parking Inc., and Sylvia Robledo d/b/a 81st Dolphin Parking v. The Board of Trustees of the Galveston Wharves and The Galveston Port Facilities Corporation, FMC No. 14-06, Order at 2 (ALJ Jan. 14, 2015) (Order Amending September 30, 2014, Discovery Schedule and Establishing Briefing Schedule). On May 1, 2015, Complainants filed the brief, proposed findings of fact, and appendix required by the Order. Proposed finding of fact number 1 sets forth at least nine factual propositions, each of which should be in a separate paragraph. Other proposed findings of fact are similarly not in compliance with this requirement of the Order.*

Therefore, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that without delay, but no later than May 18, 2015, Complainants serve and file a revised proposed findings of fact that complies with the governing Order. Complainants are not permitted to revise text, add or subtract proposed findings, or add or subtract citations to the appendix. Because this is a formatting change, not a change in substance, the date for Respondents to file their response to Complainants' proposed findings of fact, Respondents' proposed findings of fact, brief, and appendix will not be enlarged.
