

ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO EXTEND TIME TO RESPOND TO COMPLAINT

On September 8, 2014, respondent Amoy International, LLC (“Amoy International”) filed a motion seeking an extension of time to file its response to the Complaint filed by Econocaribe Consolidators, Inc. (“Econocaribe Consolidators”). Amoy International indicates that Econocaribe Consolidators agrees to the request.

Amoy International states that the person who will verify the response is out of town and will not return until September 9, 2014. The motion states good cause for the one day extension of time to file the response. The parties are reminded that pursuant to the Initial Order, a joint status report with proposed schedule is due on September 29, 2014.

Good cause having been shown, the motion for an extension of time for Amoy International to file its response to the Complaint is **GRANTED**. The other deadlines in the case remain unchanged.
