MOTION TO EXTEND TIME TO FILE MOTIONS

Pursuant to Section 502.102 of the Federal Maritime Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedures, Complainant Econocaribe Consolidators, Inc., seeks an order extending the time to file motions to Monday, March 2, 2015.


The reasons for the request are as follows. First, the discovery period will continue until February 1, 2015. Any motions to compel discovery before that time would be premature and/or unnecessary. Second, parties are still in the process of mediation being facilitated by the office of Consumer Affairs & Dispute Resolution Services. It appears that the best use of counsel's time would be focus on the mediation because a successful settlement agreement would make motions unnecessary. Third, Respondent has requested extension of time and the Commission has granted its request to respond to Complainant's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment until January 26, 2015. It would be fair to allow Complainant to file motions in accordance with Respondent's

response. Fourth, the counsel for Respondent, Joseph N. Mirkovich, Esq. has agreed to this request.


