

ORDER REQUIRING JOINT STATUS REPORT IN AUGUST

On July 22, 2015, Complainant Econocaribe Consolidators, Inc. ("Econocaribe") and Respondent Amoy International, LLC ("Amoy") filed a joint status report which indicated that the parties have reached an agreement to settle, are filing a joint stipulation for entry of judgment with the United States District Court, and would submit a settlement agreement to the Commission with the motion to dismiss.

To avoid undue delay, the parties will be required to file a joint status report by August 14, 2015, if they have not filed their settlement agreement and motion to dismiss by that date. In the joint status report, the parties should indicate when they anticipate filing the settlement and motion. Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the parties file a joint status report by August 14, 2015.
