This is in response to Docket No. 14-15 which was served me by your commission in which a motion seeking a default judgment against Oceane Cargo Link and Kingston Ansaah.

This problem occurred when an employee of my company mistakenly switched and shipped two containers to the wrong destinations at the time of loading when I had travelled overseas. I came back to meet all the mess and as the owner of the company, I take full responsibility. The other container which was involved in the switch, the cost of the cargo was not too much so we worked out something with the owners and we are paying on it. Theirs was easily taken care of because Nigeria Customs were upfront with us that the container cannot be reshipped so, it has to be cleared in Nigeria first before we can reship it. We did that and everything went smoothly. In regards to the NGOBROS container, the MSC shipping Lines and Ghana Customs lied to us which made it difficult to reship the container back to Nigeria and the cargo was confiscated by the Ghana government. We made every effort to reship the container but all we got was lies from MSC shipping lines and Ghana Customs.

Right now, the way forward is to resolve this problem. We have been going back and forth for a while, we wished this could have been resolved sooner but the problem which involved two containers, and one belonging to another party really put the company in a difficult spot financially. Below was the amount sent to us by NGOBROS:
