

**JUNE 12, 2015, ORDER TO SUPPLEMENT THE RECORD**

On June 12, 2015, the parties appeared by telephone for oral argument on Respondents' Motion for Partial Summary Decision. Complainant Baltic Auto Shipping, Inc. (Baltic) was represented by attorney Marcus A. Nussbaum and respondents Michael Hitrinov a/k/a Michael Khitrinov and Empire United Lines Co., Inc. (Empire) were represented by attorney Gerald Doyle. The conference was recorded and a transcript will be prepared.

Baltic will be supplementing the record with additional records relating to the five shipments omitted from the settlement agreement between the parties in *Baltic Auto Shipping, Inc. v. Michael Hitrinov a/k/a Michael Khitrinov, Empire United Lines Co., Inc., et al.*, No. 2:11-cv-06908-FSH (D.N.J. Dec. 7, 2011) (Stipulation and Dismissal) and the twenty-one shipments addressed in the order issued April 1, 2015. *Baltic Auto Shipping, Inc. v. Michael Hitrinov a/k/a Michael Khitrinov and Empire United Lines Co., Inc.*, FMC No. 14-16 (ALJ Apr. 1, 2015) (Order Releasing Documents Submitted *In Camera*). Baltic may want to file a post-hearing memorandum. Baltic will notify the undersigned on June 15, 2015, if it decides to file this memorandum. If it elects to file, the memorandum must be filed on or before July 10, 2015. The memorandum must not exceed 3,500 words. Empire may file a response to the post-hearing memorandum on or before July 17, 2015. The response must not exceed 3,500 words. No reply to the response is permitted.
