**Order Granting Motion for Leave to
Withdraw filed by The Law Office of Louiza
Tarassova, P.A.**

I. INTRODUCTION

On June 29, 2016, Complainants' Attorney, Louiza
Tarrasova, filed a Motion for Leave to Withdraw from

representing Crocus Investments, LLC and Crocus FZE (Complainants), following the Initial Decision in Docket 15-04, *Crocus Investments, LLC and Crocus FZE, v. Marine Transport Logistics, Inc. and Aleksandr Solovyev a/k/a Royal Finance Group, Inc.*, on June 17, 2016.

The Motion for Leave to Withdraw cites factors related to Rule 1.16 of the American Bar Association's Model Rules of Professional Conduct (A.B.A. Model Rules) and adopted by the courts, including Complainants lack of cooperation, failure to adhere to obligations regarding lawyer services, and that Complainants will not be prejudiced if a Motion for Leave to Withdraw is granted. 46 C.F.R. § 502.23(e).

Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED THAT** the Motion for Leave to Withdraw is **GRANTED**.
