ORDER TO FILE ENGLISH TRANSLATIONS OF
DOCUMENTS IN LANGUAGES OTHER THAN ENGLISH

Commission Rule 7 requires documents offered in a language other than English “be accompanied by an English translation thereof duly verified under oath to be an accurate translation.” 46 C.F.R. § 502.7. Complainants included a number of documents in their appendix that are in a language or languages other than English for which I do not find English translations verified under oath. *See, e.g.*, Complainants’ Appendix 50-52, 55, 61-62, 64-69. (This is not intended to be a list of all foreign language documents in Complainants’ Appendix.) Therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED that on or before March 17, 2016, Complainants serve and file English translations duly verified under oath of all documents in their appendix that are in a language other than English. Documents in languages other than English for which no English translation is filed may be stricken from the record.
