

ORDER TO APPEAR BY TELEPHONE FOR CLOSING ARGUMENT

The parties have filed their briefs, proposed findings of fact, and appendices, and Complainants have supplemented their appendix with English translations of documents in their appendix that had been submitted in a foreign language. Based on a review of the briefs and evidence, the undersigned has determined that closing argument would be helpful. Because Complainants' counsel is located in Florida and Respondents' counsel is located in New York, it is appropriate to conduct the argument by telephone.
