ORDER ESTABLISHING DISCOVERY DEADLINES

On March 22, 2016, the parties filed their Rule 201(b) Joint Status Report. The parties state that they have already served initial disclosures and written discovery requests. The parties propose the following discovery deadlines.

June 10, 2016	Deadline for completion of all fact witness depositions
June 15, 2016	Deadline for service of Complainant's Rule 201(d)(2) expert disclosures
June 15, 2016	Deadline for service of Respondent's Rule 201(d)(2) expert disclosures
August 4, 2016	Deadline for completion of all discovery

The above schedule is entered as an order.

The parties are ordered to file joint status reports on May 2, 2016, June 17, 2016, and July 15, 2016. In the July 15, 2016, status report, the parties must submit a joint statement on necessity for an oral hearing. If the parties contend an oral hearing is necessary, the parties must identify with particularity the issues that cannot be resolved without a hearing and/or the nature of the matters in issue that require a hearing. If the parties believe that an oral hearing is necessary, they must propose a location for the hearing. The presiding judge will determine the place of any oral hearing. If parties cannot agree on a joint statement, a party contending that an oral hearing is necessary must file a statement setting forth the reasons. A party that does not agree must file a response on or before July 22, 2016.
