**ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSIVE PLEADINGS**

On February 12, 2016, the Commission issued a Notice of Filing of Complaint and Assignment initiating this proceeding. On February 18, 2016, an Initial Order was issued. On March 7, 2016, Respondent filed a motion seeking an extension of time to March 29, 2016, to file its responsive pleading. Counsel for Respondent states that he was retained within the last six days and that he recently underwent an unexpected surgical procedure. Respondent represents that Complainant does not object to the requested extension.
