

On July 8, 2014, the Commission received complainant Okoye Christian Ogochukwu's initial filing and the Office of the Secretary docketed the filing as an informal complaint pursuant to 46 C.F.R. Subpart S. On July 9, 2014, the Settlement Officer to whom the complaint was assigned served the informal complaint and the Notice of Filing and Assignment on respondent Emeka Onyechi d/b/a Donem International, LLC. On August 4, 2014, Respondent filed an answer that included a motion to dismiss and an objection to proceeding under Subpart S; therefore, the claim is considered to be a formal complaint under 46 C.F.R. § 502.311 and will be adjudicated pursuant to 46 C.F.R. Subpart T. On October 15, 2014, the Secretary referred this proceeding to the Office of Administrative Law Judges. This proceeding is assigned to the undersigned judge who will conduct such hearings and conferences as may be necessary to resolve the issues in this proceeding and to issue an Initial Decision or dispositive ruling.
