**ORDER GRANTING SECOND REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF BRIEFING**

---

On May 29, 2015, Respondents General Noli USA, Inc. and Savino Del Bene Freight Forwarders (India) Pvt Ltd filed a letter requesting an extension of time to file their Opposition Brief from June 1, 2015, to June 25, 2015. The extension is requested to enable the parties to continue settlement discussions, including with a third party whose CEO is out of the country until June 17, 2015. The letter indicates that Complainant Smartstone Private Limited has not stated whether or not they agree to the request.

Respondents will be given the extension requested, and the schedule will be amended to reflect the extension. However, if the matter is not resolved within this time frame, the parties should be prepared to continue briefing their cases without further extension. In addition, future requests should be made in the form of a motion, not a letter, in compliance with 46 C.F.R. § 502.71.

For the reasons stated above, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the parties comply with the following amended deadlines:

June 25, 2015 Respondents shall file their Opposition Brief.

July 16, 2015 Smartstone shall file its Reply Brief.
