Pursuant to your July 29, 2015 Order, claimant Walter Muzorori (“Claimant”) and respondent CSAL Canada-States-Africa-Line, Inc. (“CSAL”) respectfully submit this joint status report regarding the status of their settlement negotiations.

CSAL made settlement offers on August 6, 2014 and March 17, 2015, respectively. Claimant rejected both offers. Claimant made a counteroffer on August 4, 2015. 
