**ORDER DISCONTINUING PROCEEDING**



The Commission issued Docket No. 99-13, a Notice of Inquiry inviting interested parties to address eight specific issues relating to the content of agreements filed with the Commission pursuant to section 4 of the Shipping Act of 1984. The Commission received five comments in response to the Notice addressing issues relating to agreement content.

By Notice issued today, the Commission instituted Docket No. 03-15, Ocean Common Carrier and Marine Terminal Operator Agreements Subject to the Shipping Act of 1984. This Notice of Proposed Rulemaking addresses the agreement content issues raised in Docket No. 99-13, as well as regulations relating to minutes filing, information form and monitoring reports, and revisions to the Commission's regulations concerning transshipment agreements. Accordingly, the Commission is now discontinuing Docket No. 99-13.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED, that this proceeding is discontinued.
