**NOTICE**

The Commission, by notice served April 27, 1993, announced its adoption of the decision of the Special Dockets Officer in this proceeding. That decision denied the application for waiver with respect to ocean freight due on household laundry equipment, and found the conditions for waiver to have been met with respect to commercial laundry equipment, subject to applicant demonstrating the amount of commercial laundry equipment shipped and the ocean freight due on that portion of the shipment.


Applicant now has submitted information demonstrating that the entire shipment consisted of commercial laundry equipment. Accordingly, the waiver is granted for the full amount of \$2788 requested.

OOCL shall file the following notice in its Tariff No. FMC 35.

Notice is hereby given, as required by the decision of the Federal Maritime Commission in Special Docket No. 2367, that effective August 31, 1992, and continuing through September 9, 1992, the D/D rate, for Commercial Laundry Equipment and Machinery from Madisonville, KY to Newbury, U.K. was \$2350 PC40. This notice is effective for purposes of refund or waiver

which may have been shipped during the specified period of time.

OOCL shall, within 30 days, waive the charges and publish and file the prescribed tariff notice and, within five days thereof, furnish the Secretary with evidence of waiver along with a copy of the prescribed tariff notice.
